NRW Education Scholarship Application Form

The Northeast Republican Women's Education Scholarship was established to honor and remember NRW members who made a significant impact on their communities as advocates, conservatives, and patriots.

Eligibility Requirements

- a. Must be a woman.
- b. Applicants must be U.S. citizens and either they or their parent(s) must be registered, active Republican voters.
- c. Applicant or parent(s) must reside in Hamilton, Warren, Clermont, or Butler County, Ohio.
- d. Applicant must be pursuing an Associate, Undergraduate, or Graduate degree, or a certification, at an accredited college or university.
- e. Applicant must demonstrate good citizenship, which may include participation in community service activities, volunteerism, etc.
- f. Applicant must maintain a minimum grade-point average of 3.0 (or equal to or above the school average).
- g. Preferred areas of study include the social sciences; other areas of study are eligible and will be considered.
- h. The \$1,000 scholarship will be granted for a one-year period. Previous scholarship recipients may reapply if the grade-point average and citizenship criteria described above are maintained. At the committee's discretion, additional scholarships may be granted.
- i. Scholarship recipients who fail to maintain the requisite grade-point average and citizenship criteria will be ineligible for future grants from the Scholarship Fund.
- j. Disbursements from the Scholarship Fund will be issued directly to the applicant's educational institution.
- k. Winning students agree to attend an NRW meeting to be awarded the scholarship. Applicants must give written approval to the NRW Club to use their name and photo for NRW scholarship promotions.

2. Transcript

Please attach an official transcript from your high school and/or college. Transcripts should include your cumulative GPA, class rank (if available), and a list of completed and in-progress courses. If obtaining an official transcript is cost-prohibitive, an unofficial transcript will be accepted and vetted by the Scholarship Committee.

3. Letter of Recommendation

Please provide a letter of recommendation from a non-family member (teacher, counselor, employer, or other individual who can speak to your academic achievements, character, and integrity). The letter must be signed by the recommender and include the recommender's contact information.

4. Essay

Provide a typed essay (1–2 pages, 500–800 words) addressing the following prompt:

“We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.”

Before 1776, the “proven” model of government for thousands of years was monarchy—power handed down from the top by birthright or divine decree. The American Founders boldly declared the opposite: every person is created equal by God, not by government, and rights come straight from the Creator, not from any king.

As America celebrates its 250th anniversary in 2026:

- Tell the story of one specific moment in your life (a family dinner, a classroom debate, a local town hall meeting, a Fourth of July gathering, or even a conversation with friends) when those immortal words suddenly felt real to you. Describe exactly what happened, what you said or did, how others reacted, and how that moment made you feel proud (or maybe even a little nervous) to be a young Republican woman living out the exact opposite of monarchy.
- Then reflect: How does this 1776 declaration of equality and God-given rights still shape your conservative values today and inspire your plans for education, career, and civic leadership?

5. Video

Submit a video (3 minutes or less) of yourself explaining why you are applying for this scholarship. Email the video file or provide a link to it on YouTube, X, Rumble, or any platform of your choice.

6. Resume / Extracurricular Activities

Attach your resume and a list of your extracurricular activities (e.g., sports, volunteering, leadership roles, religious or political activities).

7. Criminal Background (other than minor traffic violations)

As part of our application process, we ask applicants to disclose any past criminal convictions or pending charges. Disclosure of a criminal history will not automatically disqualify you; each case will be reviewed individually. Please provide details of any past convictions or pending charges (or state “None”).

8. Attestation

I certify that all information provided in this scholarship application is true, accurate, and complete to the best of my knowledge. I understand that any false or misleading information or plagiarism may disqualify me from consideration for the scholarship. As part of my application, I agree that if I win the scholarship, I give permission to the NRW Club to use my picture and name in their scholarship promotional materials.
